Some lines that did jump out at me: He offers food to those who are laboring with bodily toil; then He calls the resting souls whose bodies are laid aside, to drink; and finally He urges those who have resumed their bodies to drink abundantly. By that, Bernard means that a Christian should not love God for the benefit he will receive. O pure and cleansed purpose, thoroughly washed and purged from any admixture of selfishness, and sweetened by contact with the divine will! The unmingled wine would enrapture the soul and make her wholly unconscious of self; but here is no such transport for she is still desirous of her body. But even though the frightful pain could not destroy their peace of mind, it must be the real story of Christianity?
