Concept of Operations – Forms the main part of the plan, provides the details on the EM governance structure, and assigns specific tasks for each phase of the EM process. management EM refers to the management of emergencies concerning all hazards, including all activities and risk management measures related to prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response and recovery. Risks should be described in a way that conveys their context, point of origin and potential impact.
